

## **Request for Driver Evaluation**

To report an unsafe driver, use form OC-88 "Request for Driver Evaluation" available from the Secretary of State Office or available on line at [www.michigan.gov/sos](http://www.michigan.gov/sos) listed under Quick Find "Forms."

### Procedure:

1. Complete form OC-88. Under section 2, list why driver appears unsafe such as accidents or any physical or mental conditions that affect their driving ability. It is helpful if multiple parties submit forms, like family members as well as doctor, neighbors, police, etc. who are aware of the safety concerns.
2. Send completed form to MI Dept of State office address listed above.
3. If State determines just cause for concern, State sends letter to unsafe driver requiring a re-examination of driving ability with appointment date at local Secretary of State office.
4. State *may* require driver to bring a letter from their doctor saying they are mentally and physically able to take the driving exam.
5. At driver re-evaluation appointment, a vision, written, and/or road test are given.
6. If driver disregards letter to appear for re-examination, driver's license is suspended.

Referring parties are anonymous "to extent of the law." Their names are not provided on the notice of re-evaluation letter nor are they given out if driver requests the information. Referring names can only be released if driver formerly appeals to State for that information and if the State reviews appeal and determines it warrants release of that information.
