INTERSECTION TRAFFIC CONTROL

Purpose:

Effective with the adoption of this policy, the Board of Jackson County Commissioners establishes that all crossroads located upon the primary and local road system shall be protected by the installation of one or more stop signs or yield signs. In addition, the review of "T" intersections to determine if additional traffic control may be warranted is encouraged.

- A. The Director of Engineering is responsible for developing, maintaining, and implementing an evaluation/implementation plan to determine sign type and placement.
- B. As part of new plat development, it will be the responsibility of the developer to reimburse the County for initial installation of signs required for placement. Thereafter, signs will be maintained and replaced at no additional external cost.
- C. Following completion of the initial program as cited above, the Director of Engineering is responsible for reviewing existing intersection signing, and determining appropriate changes based on sound engineering judgment. Replacement signing costs will be borne internally.
