

Falling Waters Trail rules and Courtesies



- Trail is open daily from sunrise to sunset.
- Obey all trail and traffic signs.
- All trails are designated for pedestrians or non-motorized transportation only. Horses are not permitted. No person shall operate an ATV, ORV, snowmobile, mini-bike, scooter, go-cart or similar motorized device.
- Pets must be on a leash no more than 6 feet long and owners must clean up after their pets.
- Hunting/Trapping: All hunting and trapping is prohibited on the 100ft. Trail right-of-way. Discharge of a firearm or a bow is prohibited on the 100ft. Trail right-of-way. Shooting a weapon across the 100ft. Trail right-of-way is prohibited.

Falling Waters Trail Courtesies

1. Always wear a bicycle helmet.
2. Cyclists and skaters must yield to pedestrians.
3. Keep right and pass left. Give audible warning before passing.
4. Respect private property and other trail users.
5. Clean up after your pets.
6. Do not block the trail. Travel in single file.
7. Travel at a safe speed in a predictable route.
8. Stay on the designated trail.
9. Be courteous and have fun!
